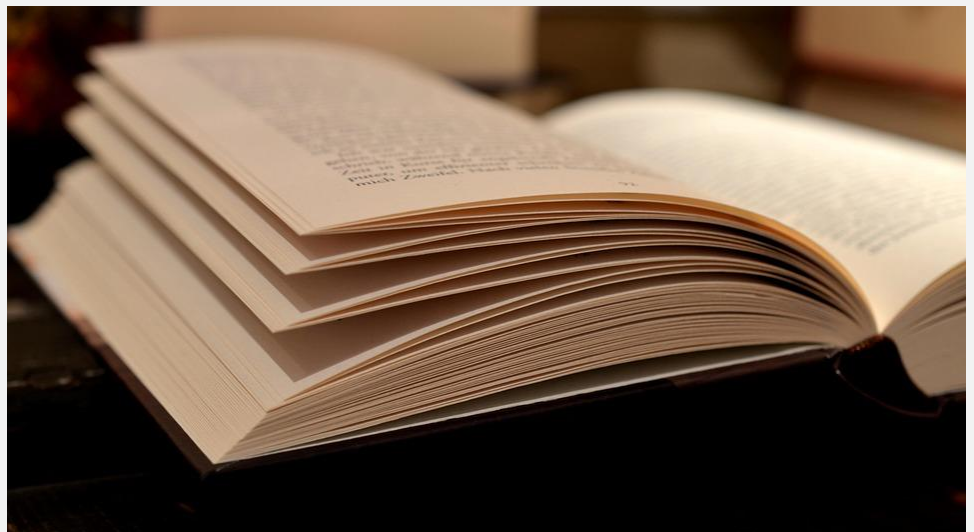

近年來，先進治療科技和護理措施的改進，大大提高了兒童癌症的5年存活率。如今，愈來愈多的年輕兒童癌症病人能活到成年。然而，癌症治療可能對倖存者身心健康產生不良影響，包括癌症相關的疲勞、心理困擾、焦慮和憂鬱症狀。這些不良影響可在治療完成後持續數年，嚴重影響他們的自信心和生活質素。現有的倖存者復康計劃旨在幫助他們應對治療的潛在後遺症，並提供生理和心理支持。然而，香港尚未有為兒童倖存者提供持續護理的復康計劃。

我們獲得了醫療衛生研究基金的資助，進行了一項研究，探討兒童癌症個案在從患者到倖存者的轉變過程中，所面臨的挑戰和需求，並探討香港兒童倖存者復康計劃的可行性和發展。我們採用了目的抽樣的質性描述設計，對30名年齡在9至18歲之間的兒童癌症倖存者及其父母/照顧者，以及5名兒童癌症腫瘤科護士和3名兒童腫瘤專家進行訪談。

訪談得出了4個主要主題：1. 重返學校的挑戰；2. 與身心健康有關的擔憂；3. 缺乏社會支持和適應困難；以及4. 對支持護理服務的需求。

研究結果深入了解兒童癌症倖存者、他們的父母和醫療專業人士觀點。這些見解表明，應在香港建立兒童癌症倖存者復康計劃，作為癌症治療連續過程的重要組成部分。由於護理主導的復康計劃具有可行性和經濟效益，因此成為一種潛在模式。護士應超越現有角色，與教育部門、學校社工和輔導員合作，為兒科患者提供心理教育和支持，使他們能滿懷希望和信念繼續人生旅程。
